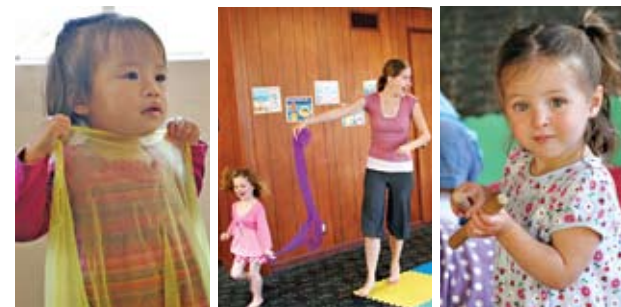

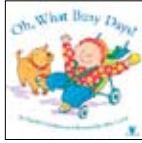

Semester 4 - Part 2
